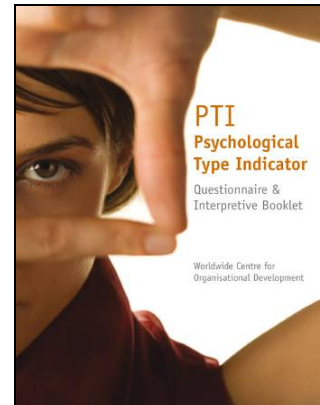

The PTI is taken by undertaking a 116 question on-line assessment which then produces a short descriptive report for the individual, which includes the personal results and then some useful interpretive data as a basis for further study and reflection. The report identifies which one of 16 possible types is the most preferred based on the answers given and then talks about characteristics of this type (summarized in the diagram shown here to the left).

The product family also includes two other assessments, also based on Jungian theory. These are the Management Team Roles Indicator (MTRI®) and the Ideal Team Preferences Questionnaire (ITPQ). These both extend the 16 types model to team situations and preferences.
